



## OUR HISTORY

Narrow Valley Wines initiated in 2006. Founded by Alan Epstein and Nicolas Saelzer, with over 40 years of combined wine experience, they began planting the Curacavi section of world class Maipo valley under organic philosophy and pioneering hillside planting in this part of Maipo valley. In 2012 Narrow Valley began exports to the international markets, reaching North America, Europe and Asia in record time. With a philosophy of delivering premium Chilean value wines in all categories (Gran Reserva, Reserva and Classic wines), our wines are enjoyed today in the most demanding international markets including USA, UK and China among many others. In 2014 we acquired a new estate in the Calera section of Maipo valley, in between the Andes mountains and the Coastal range and near the Maipo river, planted in 2015 with Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Carmenere. In 2016 we began construction of new winemaking and bottling facilities in Calera. During 2016 and early 2017 we have imported all new production equipment from Italy to deliver our wines under the highest quality standards.



## GRAN RESERVA



Our Narrow Valley Gran Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon is a tribute to the long and successful history of winemaking in world class Maipo Valley, home the best wines from Chile. Crafted from hand harvested selected grapes from our Calera and Curacavi estates in the heart of the valley, the wine is fermented and kept in French and American oak including new barrels for over 12 months. This complex and intense wine shows the full expression of the grapes from Maipo. Long lasting, balanced with ripe tannins, our Cabernet Gran Reserva is ideal for special occasions and celebrations.



**NORTH** - Atacama, 760 miles north of Santiago is the driest non-polar desert in the world.



**SOUTH** - Torres del Paine, 1.186 miles from Santiago is the 5th most beautiful place in the world by the National Geographic.



**EAST** - Santiago (capital), with the Andes background and the tallest building in South America.



**WEST** - Pacific Ocean coastline at Viña del Mar city, just 60 miles west of Santiago.

## CHILE, VITICULTURAL PARADISE:

Almost five thousand kilometers long and just one hundred and twenty kilometers of average width, Chile is considered a viticultural paradise for its multiple terroirs. With the driest desert in the world in the north, Antarctica in the south, the Andes mountains in the east and the Pacific Ocean to the west Chile has unique phytosanitary conditions and is the only free phylloxera country in the world. With the highest temperature oscillation, we benefit from cool mornings and evenings and warm days increasing grapes complexity. The lack of rain during the summer season makes it the best place to ripen grapes to their full maturity including Carmenere, unique to Chile due to its need for long and dry ripeness, thus being the last grape variety to be harvested in the season. All in all Chile produces some of the best wines in the world under some of the best conditions for sustainable, organic, and biodynamic farming.




